BANJO MAKING workshops for young folks are a blast !!

They involve basic carpentry skills such as sanding, hammering, hand-drilling, installing a small screw and screw-eye and gluing. Children are carefully instructed and supervised each step of the way by experienced leader, Purly Gates. The result is a nifty, tuneable and playable jug banjo.

Purly usually provides all materials and tools (except when travelling by plane). Workshops run from 1 to 1.5 hrs. If there is time, participants also learn to play a simple song on their banjos.

Group size is limited to 12 participants. Recommended for ages 8-12.

Fees start at \$150 for one workshop; discounts for multiple sessions, block-bookings or for bookings in conjunction with a concert.
